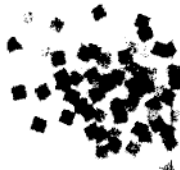

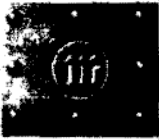

Hello Erin. As we discussed this morning, there was a small incident yesterday involving our people and a couple of the rainbows. Our folks were trying to find a way down to a nearby creek to collect water samples and drove by a heavily "populated" area to the dislike of the individuals in the area. On their last pass through, they were stopped and expressed their concern about them driving through their area so many times demanding to know what they were doing. Our folks explained what they were doing and proceeded to drive off. As they drove off, one of the Rainbow participants reached into the vehicle and grabbed the steering wheel and advised our folks they weren't done talking to them. They continued to express their dismay, and finally let them drive away. Our folks were a little rattled but dealt with the situation appropriately. I intend to talk to Garrick and let him know that this isn't acceptable and is an example of how this can lead to a situation where things can get out of hand.

Now its official: **The "Rainbow Famil Living Light" large annual gathering will be on the Santa Fe N.F.--Cuba Ranger District northeast of community of Cuba in the Parque Venado area.**

I've attached a simple fact sheet on the Rainbow Family of Living Light gathering in which approximately 5,000 to 7,000 will gather around their big day, July 4th when they form a huge circle to pray for world peace.

In the meantime, Rainbows from all over the US are starting their trek to NM.

How does the Forest Service manage this event?

The agency:

Locates suitable sites in the region selected for the gathering before it occurs and strives to secure the group's agreement to gather there.

Attempts to gain compliance from the Rainbow Family in the permitting process generally.

Addresses health and safety risks to the public and participants from the gathering.

Minimizes environmental impacts from the gathering with the presence of law enforcement, resource, and special uses personnel.

Identifies and mitigates social and political impacts from the gathering.

Respects the rights of all members of the public, including gathering attendees.

Utilizes a unified command system and works with state, county, and local law enforcement and public health agencies and other organizations.

We held a public meeting in Cuba on June 3rd to give them a heads-up about the possibility of the Rainbow gathering. The Mayor of Cuba has requested another meeting next Wednesday, June 17th.

We have a local team established that is moving quickly into managing this "event" the best we can and working with the communities that may be affected. Erin Connelly is functioning as Agency Administrator and Derek Padilla as Incident Commander. A national incident management team is gathering also to assist with the Rainbow gathering under a unified command system. When the team arrives, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] LE&I and Derek Padilla will manage the event.

Forest Service goal is to have a safe, peaceful gathering, mitigating as many impacts to communities, and forest resources as possible.

We've had great support from the Carson and Gila National forests and the Regional Office thus far. We sure appreciate this.

Thank you for your prompt reply. I have already spoken with Village of Cuba to request law enforcement presence at our food pantry when we distribute food; the first and third Thursday of every month from 4 pm to 5:30pm.

Nacimiento Medical Foundation's policies governing food distribution require proof of residency in three counties, Sandoval, McKinley and Rio Arriba, therefore any Rainbow Family members attempting to access the food pantry will be denied. Given the numbers of people attending the Gathering, it is highly likely that we will get a large influx of people wanting food who are ineligible to receive it. We hope to avert any problems or confrontations before they happen, but a strong presence of law enforcement will help deal with any problems/confrontations should they arise. I wasn't sure if Forest Service personnel would be able to assist in this area, so I thought I would ask. I do understand your restrictions.
