I received a phone call from a Kevin Carmichael from New Castle who is a camp owner in the Tidoute area near the Gathering. He was planning to come here over the 4th and he and his family wondered about their safety and had a number of questions. I spoke to him for quite awhile, explained what we are doing as far as outreaching in the community, our Incident Management Team, 911 dispatch, etc. I explained that with the additional FS law enforcement presence that would allow the State Police and other local law enforcement agencies to patrol the outlying communities and I also told him that I've heard that the 911 system is now fully operational in all areas of the counties and so if they did have an incident of any kind they should see quick response times as well. I am putting him on the email list to receive our daily updates and told him our phone numbers are on them in case he has other concerns or questions. He was extremely appreciative of the return phone call, the information and placing him on our daily update email list.

If you have any questions in the next couple hours, please call my cell phone 906-202-2762.
I'm going to the field to check on our information folks stationed on the road (see info below). This is their first day out.

Approximately 1,300 people are at the gathering (estimated through vehicle counts)

There are around 300 reported incidents.

About 60% are warnings and incident reports (not tickets). Incident reports are an observed violation – they are not attached to an individual. A written warning is associated with a person; there are no fines, but it constitutes a "written reprimand" (so-to-speak) of an observed violation.

About 40% are tickets:

- Approximately ¼ of those are traffic related. There are about 300 vehicles (cars and buses). We do not feel the amount of traffic tickets is unusual given the number of vehicles present and the additional vehicles that are just traveling through the area.
- Drug related violations constitute about 40-45% of the tickets. Tickets may result in a fine and may require a court appearance.

We do not have any check-points where vehicles check-in or are routinely stopped

Officers only pull over vehicles when they observe a violation.

The event is growing daily in numbers of people and numbers of vehicles. We are working cooperatively with other area law enforcement agencies (state, county and local), EMS organizations and other cooperators to manage for the health and safety of gathering participants.

In addition to safety, another one of our primary objectives is protection of resource values in the area. We have resource specialists in the field working directly with Rainbow members for proper placement of campsites and campfires, sanitation guidelines, watershed protection, vehicle parking and control of pets. Rainbows are helping us sign areas with sensitive wildlife or plant communities.

We realize the public is naturally curious about the gathering. We've been putting out updates to area communities and businesses every other day. Starting next week, we will do this daily.

Starting today and for the next week, we have Forest Service information staff located on the way to the gathering providing our key messages. They have posters stating "Only You Can....Keep the Water Clean, Keep the Forest Clean, Keep the Roads Open and Be Safe" If folks choose to stop, our staff are available to talk with anyone about resource protection and safety.

If you are interested in getting a photo of them, they are located on the 119 road east of the gathering.

Road information:

Warren County

The full width Recycled Asphalt Paving on Heart's Content is completed.
We will have crews working to complete paving around the Vandergrift intersection Wednesday and
Thursday of this week.
Minister Road will be closed Friday, June 18th from Heart's Content to SR 666 for approximately 7 hours
during the day.
All signs and equipment should be removed from the area by Friday evening, weather permitting.
The shoulders will be backed up after the second week in July.

Forest County

The full width Recycled Asphalt Paving on Minister from SR 666 to the Warren County line is completed.
We do plan to have a crew backing up the shoulders on Minister from SR 666 to the Warren County line
on June 28th and 29th.
None of this work requires a road closure and traffic will be controlled by flagmen.

Heart's Content Road never had posted speed limit signs. It is typical for the Department to receive concerns after paving gravel roads. Without a posted speed limit the legal limit is 55 mph. The process for a legal and enforceable posting reducing the speed would take some time. The District Traffic Unit would review the road, make a determination based on their study and recommend a speed and location of signs. The problem with these remote areas is that it becomes an enforcement issue even when posted.

That doesn't help your concern for the couple of weeks during the Rainbow Gathering. We have low shoulder signs along with work area signs already in place but obviously that is not slowing traffic down according to your officers.

We can add additional warning signs if you feel it would help.

Subject: National Gathering of the Rainbow Family: Update

Hello everyone,

I had notified some of you last week that the Allegheny National Forest is on the short list (of about 8 National Forests) as a possible location for the annual Rainbow Family of Living Light National Gathering from mid-June to mid-July. The ANF has been the site of this event in the past (in 1986 in the Queen Creek area of Forest and Warren Counties, and again in 1999 in the Bear Creek area of Elk County). The event can include up to 8-12,000 people from around the country. We have been told that the location of the Spring Council to select the National Gathering spot gives some indication of the location of the National Gathering itself (it is usually within 100 miles of the Council location).

We received word over the weekend that the Rainbow Family has selected the Owis Nest area of Elk County for their Spring Council on June 4-6 (this upcoming weekend). The Council may attract as many as 200 people, who could begin arriving in the area any day. I have attached a link to one of the Rainbow websites with the information on the Spring Council:
